SHELTER IN PLACE



Restrict movement due to **armed gunman** in vicinity.
Run- if possible, evacuate the area if you can do so safely.
Hide- turn off all lights, lock doors and windows, silence phones. Hide under desk or behind objects, barricade door.
Fight, as a last resort, throw items, improvise weapons

Directs facility occupants to **remain indoors** and avoid all exterior doors and windows. It is issued by first responders primarily to protect occupants from possible **fragmentation dangers** associated with a threat in a nearby area

Used when **air-borne contaminants** are located in your area and evacuation from your facility would be more hazardous to personnel. Upon notification, alert personnel to Shelter in Place. **Secure your building.** Cover SIP room doors, vents and windows with plastic and duct tape. Turn off HVAC if able and notify Control Center of status
